Master of Psychology is a high-level professional, prepared for scientific research, and for solving various practical problems.

The Institute of World Civilizations trains masters in the field of "Psychology of Labor, Engineering Psychology", in demand of various enterprises. Master's training can undergo one who has a Bachelor's Degree or a Diploma of Specialist.

The curriculum for Master's training includes a cycle of different academic disciplines. Methodological problems of psychology, qualitative and quantitative methods of research in psychology, computer technologies in science and education, actual problems of theory and practice of labor psychology and engineering psychology, planning of theoretical and empirical research are being studied. Master students study basic disciplines, such as psychological service in the organization, actual problems of the psychology of personnel management, psychological aspects of personnel evaluation, psychological principles and methodology of conducting business training, psychological principles of vocational guidance and professional self-determination etc.

In the process of studying, undergraduates develop skills of psychological and pedagogical activity, which makes it possible to engage in teaching activities. The research program provides an opportunity to carry out scientific research that can be used in the theses and publications.

Regional studies (foreign regional studies) is a relatively new area of training in the system of Russian higher education. For those who already have a Diploma of higher education (specialist, bachelor), the Institute of World Civilizations offers a master's program in the field of "Foreign Regional Studies".

Master of Regional Studies is a direction rarely encountered in our country. Not all institutes are ready to carry out such training, limiting themselves to a bachelor's degree. Meanwhile, obtaining a master's degree opens the possibility of enrolling in graduate school. In addition, the Master is a specialist capable of a deeper analysis, prepared for analytical work, consulting and research.

Master of Regional Studies is an opportunity to supplement your higher education, which increases the chances of becoming an employee of a successful Russian or foreign company.
